

## The School of Spiritual Science Its Significance and Purpose

Rudolf Steiner founded the School of Spiritual Science at the Christmas Conference in 1923/24. Henceforth, he said the School would be understood as an "esoteric" institution. He clearly repudiated previous efforts by Goetheanum colleagues to model the Dornach work on already existing academic institutions. The newly founded School of Spiritual Science would appear as an esoteric school. All scientific and artistic activities in Dornach would be carried by this esoteric school and its training – the substance of which in terms of research, teaching and education, would contribute to contemporary civilization. The new school would thereby form the core and soul of the refounded Anthroposophical Society, making the implementation of anthroposophy a "serious" matter, and building a "rock for anthroposophy" instead of the previous attitude of "laziness". It is about truly taking responsibility for the world's needs and the actual realization of spiritual impulses. "It is necessary to engage more strongly than before if the spirit which humanity needs is to be effective."

The annual meeting of the Anthroposophical Society in Switzerland is a reflection of the motives and intentions of the School, in a dramatic new world situation. What is to be its contribution to the future?
